

M1860 LIGHT CAVALRY SABER - 2ND MASS CAV

Very fine model 1860 Cav Saber - 2nd Mass Cav markings and excellent condition Ames blade, marked US and 1865 inspector's markings J.C.W. at ricasso. Opposite side is Ames marking. On inside face of knuckle bow is regimental marking 2 MS CAV with identical though faint marking on right side of scabbard drag. Brass shows a beautiful and untouched honey gold patina. The leather grip is nearly 100% with original wire wrap. The metal scabbard shows a nice even toned patina with two very minor dents close to drag. Rounded edge of drag shows some ground wear and ring/mounts show signs of use.

This is a very fine example of a light Cav saber with the additional bonus of original regimental markings placing it in use by a trooper of the 2nd Massachusetts Cavalry.
